### **Call for Applications for the Visiting Scholars Program of the Leibniz Institute for East and Southeast European Studies (IOS) Regensburg in 2022**

The Leibniz Institute for East and Southeast European Studies, IOS (<https://www.leibniz-ios.de/>) in Regensburg is one of the largest and longest-established institutions of its kind in Germany with an international and multi-disciplinary profile. The IOS maintains one of the leading specialized libraries for East and Southeast European Studies. It is an independent research facility with close links to the University of Regensburg. In 2019, IOS and the University of Regensburg established the Leibniz ScienceCampus “Europe and America in the Modern World: Frictions and Transformations of Globality since the 19th Century” ([www.europeamerica.de](http://www.europeamerica.de)).

We now invite applications for our 2022 Visiting Research Fellow Program. We particularly encourage historians, economists, political scientists and scholars of cognate disciplines to apply. Fellows are expected to conduct research relevant to the research profile of the institute and of the Leibniz ScienceCampus. As an Area Studies institute, IOS promotes comparative and trans-regional perspectives.

Fellows usually stay between two and a maximum of four weeks. The allowance is determined by the length of stay and the applicant’s professional experience. The **2G rule** applies at the IOS. Proof of vaccination or recovery is a prerequisite for visiting the institute.

Please submit your application online until **November 30, 2021**, via the IOS application portal at <https://www.ios-regensburg.de/en/visiting-fellows-program.html>. The application documents must include:

- a short research proposal in German or English (maximum three pages)
- a detailed academic Curriculum Vitae naming two references
- copies of no more than three academic articles (published or unpublished)
- statement on the preferred length and period of your stay. **The awarded fellowship can be started in the second half of the year 2022 (i.e. from July)!**
